Featured Grant Recipient: Dr. Duncan Wigg

Dr. Duncan Wigg, GSEP/Psychology, has received two grants in the past year for the Pepperdine University Mental Health Collaborative (PUMHC). PUMHC has, since September 2008, been providing mental health counseling services to homeless individuals, couples and families in residence at the Village of Hope, a 192-bed transitional living facility located in Tustin, CA and operated by the Orange County Rescue Mission. The first grant was from the Healthcare Foundation for Orange county to assist with providing clinical supervision to students. The second grant was from the Orange County Community Foundation and a donor advised foundation that wishes to remain anonymous. The gift provided complete furnishings for the four counseling rooms. PUMHC has a strong commitment to creating an attractive, comfortable and welcoming counseling environment for the residents of the Village of Hope. The PUMHC is currently providing over 2,150 mental health counseling sessions per year, assisting the homeless in overcoming the profound mental health problems that significantly compromise their efforts towards self-sufficiency.
