

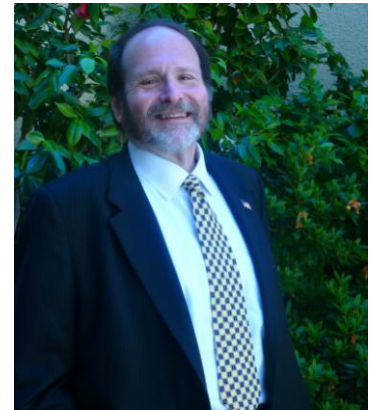

### Featured Grant Recipient: Dr. Bruce Einhorn

The Asylum and Refugee law Clinic of the Pepperdine University School of Law has been awarded \$70,000 over the next two years to support its *pro bono* representation under faculty supervision by Pepperdine law students of indigent victims of religious and other forms of persecution who seek legal status in the United States. The gift comes from the New York-based Fridolin Foudation, founded by a Holocaust survivor. The \$70,000 will help hire the many necessary interpreters, therapists, medical doctors, and expert witnesses on foreign country conditions, and also help finance student travel to immigration proceedings in Southern California and elsewhere in the U.S. Additionally, the donated funds will greatly assist in the purchase and use of much-needed audio-visual equipment and other technology designed to help prepare students and the Clinic’s clients for government-directed interviews and interrogations, and Clinic-directed witness examinations, to which the asylum seekers will be subject in their applications for refugee status.



Since its establishment in the fall semester of 2008, the Asylum Clinic, under the direction of its Founding Director and Supervising Professor, Judge Bruce J. Einhorn (ret.) - the author of the modern U.S. law of asylum - has grown to be the largest and busiest clinic of its kind in the nation. It has not yet lost a single case. “We are experiencing the growing pains of our success,” notes Judge Einhorn. “As a result of our burgeoning case load and the cultural and ethnic diversity of our clients, these outside gifts enhance our efforts to protect the rights of those broken souls whose only ‘crime’ has been to profess their faith in G-d as they see fit.. Thanks to the generosity of the Fridolin Foundation, the Pepperdine Asylum Clinic will go from strength to strength, defend the defenseless, and in doing so further our University’s values of purpose, service, and leadership.”
