### FEATURED GRANT RECIPIENTS

#### DR. CARY MITCHELL

The Graduate School of Education and Psychology (“GSEP”) received a second grant from the QueensCare Foundation, in the amount of \$35,000 for the continued support of the Psychological Wellness Program at the Union Rescue Mission (“URM”), led by Dr. Cary Mitchell, professor of psychology, and Dr. Aaron Aviera, senior clinical faculty. The Psychological Wellness Program is a partnership to provide mental health treatment services to homeless men and women in recovery programs at URM. Recent statistics report that in 2013, Los Angeles County had approximately 57,700 homeless individuals, and over 30% met criteria for mental illness.

Since 2001, GSEP has collaborated with URM to address the psychological healthcare needs of this disadvantaged, underserved, and vulnerable population. Through this unique partnership, clinical psychology doctoral candidates provide much needed mental health services to homeless persons at URM, while receiving supervision and advanced training. One goal of the project is to better prepare future psychologists to meet the mental health treatment needs of homeless, poor, and marginalized communities.

Dr. Thomas Reilly, professor of Chinese history at Seaver College, received a \$30,000 grant from the Chiang Ching-kuo Foundation for International Scholarly Exchange to research and author a book on the history of Chinese Protestant social reformers during China’s republican period and their influence on the urban elite during the years of shifting political alliances. Dr. Reilly will be specifically focusing his research on the role of the YMCA as one of the most influential social organizations in the years of the Chinese republic.

This book will serve as a culmination of his research over the past eight years, where he has spent summers and sabbaticals compiling, copying, organizing, and studying the primary source materials required for his research. Throughout the course of his research for this project, Dr. Reilly has gathered materials from the Shanghai Municipal City Archive, the Shanghai City Library, the National Christian Council archives at Huadong Seminary, the Hong Kong Baptist University Chinese Christianity archive, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the International YMCA archive at the University of Minnesota, the Presbyterian Historical Archive, Yale Divinity School’s Day Missions Library, and university libraries across the U.S.
