FEATURED GRANT RECIPIENT

DR. ANTHONY COLLATOS, associate professor of education at the Graduate School of Education and Psychology, has been the recent recipient of two grants for his work with foster and low-income youth.



THE CONRAD N. HILTON FOUNDATION has awarded a \$250,000 grant to develop and implement the Youth Higher Education Access Collaborative (FYHEAC), a comprehensive college access program that addresses the academic and wellness needs of high school foster youth and their families. This is a GSEP joint effort between Dr. Collatos of the Education Division and Dr. Donald Grant of the Psychology Division.

The FYHEAC pilot program will partner with the Lynwood Unified School District with the goal of creating a sustainable model that can be implemented in other schools and organizations serving foster youth and their families. FYHEAC will provide the necessary skills, tools, and environmental support for the foster youth and their families to successfully navigate entry into a two- or four- year college or university or other institutions providing technical, trade, or vocational certification or licensure.

THE CAROL AND JAMES COLLINS FOUNDATION has awarded Dr. Collatos with a \$15,000 grant to continue his work implementing 21st century science labs at elementary schools in the community of Huntington Park. The Collins Foundation grant will be used to establish a science lab at Miles Avenue/Miles Math, Science and Technology Magnet School. This grant will provide students access to a fully equipped laboratory and improve student proficiency in science and technology.



This is Dr. Collatos' second grant from the foundation. In 2013, he was awarded with a \$10,000 grant that funded a science lab at Huntington Park Elementary School (HPES). Working in partnership with the 4th and 5th grade teachers at HPES and Sharefest Inc., Dr. Collatos was able to successfully implement a science lab that allowed teachers and students to access the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). These resources included technology, multiple, biomes, an aquaponics system, and digital microscopes. The grand opening celebration of the science lab was featured on KLCS (PBS Los Angeles) and Univision.
