Featured Grant Recipient: Angela Hawken

Dr. Angela Hawken received funding from the Smith Richardson Foundation in 2007 to conduct a randomized controlled trial of Hawaii's Opportunity Probation with Enforcement (HOPE). HOPE targets high-risk felony probationers and uses a regimen of regular, random drug testing tied to swift and certain—but relatively mild—sanctions to reduce drug use and drug-related crime. The findings from the randomized controlled trial were striking. With reductions in drug use of more than 80% plus reductions in new arrests and incarceration and therefore public-sector costs, HOPE represents a potential revolution in corrections and in drug policy. In December 2009, Drug Czar, Gil Kerlikowske, identified HOPE as *the* most promising initiative that "...not only prevents recidivism, but also actively assists individuals to transition to productive lives." Based on these promising findings, many states have now implemented their own HOPE programs. In July 2010 Dr. Hawken received a \$235,670 grant from the Smith Richardson Foundation to conduct a three-year followup of the original research subjects in Hawaii. Hawken's team will collect data on crime and incarceration and will study drug use from hair samples collected from subjects. The purpose of this study is to determine whether the good outcomes observed under HOPE persist after probation is completed.
