The Seaver College-Glenwood Elementary Professional Development School

A Professional Development School is a unique and replicable partnership between a university and a K-12 school with the goal to create an integrated learning community benefiting the school students, student teachers, master teachers, faculty, and administrators. Carrie Birmingham, Associate Professor of Teacher Education at Seaver College was awarded a grant by the Wood-Claeyssens Foundation to develop a PDS between Seaver College and Glenwood Elementary in Thousand Oaks. This grant will support the development of the Seaver-Glenwood PDS. It will also enable them to work with the already established GSEP-EARTHS Elementary PDS, under the direction of Kathy Church, in order to learn from their experience. Yas Djadali, Assistant Director of Career Services for GSEP facilitated the *Strengths in Education in Teaching* workshop with the PDS teachers. The program is designed to support individual teaching strengths to improve teaching, learning, communication, and collaboration. This is a true Pepperdine collaborative project.
