**THE FLETCHER JONES FOUNDATION**

Professorships and chairs are important to the University's ability to recruit and retain high-quality faculty, and the Fletcher Jones Foundation is a major partner in this effort. The Foundation has endowed the **Fletcher Jones Chair in Western Culture** at Seaver College, which will oversee a three-course sequence in western civilization, spanning from prehistoric times to the Middle Ages, the Renaissance to the French Revolution, and an upper division course focusing on cultural literacy in modern culture. The inaugural chairholder is **Dr. Phillip Freeman**, who has previously held positions at Luther College, Harvard Divinity School, and Washington University. The Fletcher Jones Foundation has also previously established the Fletcher Jones Chair in Great Books and Professorship in Middle Eastern Studies.

**THE WILLIAM E. SIMON FOUNDATION**

The School of Public Policy has received a grant from the William E. Simon Foundation for the **William E. Simon Distinguished Visiting Professorship**. The foundation has supported the professorship since 2006, allowing SPP to bring nationally recognized policy scholars to Pepperdine. This year's visiting professors are **Dr. Lanhee Chen** from Stanford University who will be teaching a seminar on "Public Policy Making in Today's Political Environment" in the fall, and **Dr. Jeffrey Sikkenga** from Ashland University who will be teach "Religious Liberty and the Supreme Court" in spring 2018.
