As a result, Pepperdine alumni who now work for Target, return to campus each year to recruit students for their management training program. The success of this partnership, led Target to award a Campus Grant to the Seaver College Career Center to fund a leadership development and convocation series for students called *Lead D.E.E.P – Diversity Explored by Emerging Professionals*.

Students will meet in January to discuss issues of diversity including education, economic background, ethnicity, sex, religion, and health. Participants will be given a copy of the book “What if?
