Fletcher Jones Foundation Grant Helps Build 21st Century Library for Pepperdine University

The Fletcher Jones Foundation has reaffirmed its long-standing commitment to support academic learning and intellectual curiosity by granting \$500,000 toward the renovation of Pepperdine University's Payson Library. In acknowledgement of its support of the Great Books Program Chair over the past 18 years, Mark Roosa, Dean of Libraries, announced that one of the signature spaces in Payson Library will be named *The Fletcher Jones Foundation Great Books Room*. Roosa says, "It is essential that Payson Library meet the highest standards of academic excellence, and this gift will support our overall goal of transforming Payson into a premier 21st century library."

The newly named *Fletcher Jones Foundation Great Books Room* is home to the Great Books program, which was designed to support a very special kind of pedagogy—shared inquiry, as the professor and students engage in Socratic discussion of the selected great books that form the heart of the program.

A renovated Payson Library will ensure President Andrew K. Benton's stated goal that, "Almost more than any other physical element of the academic journey ahead, we must be successful in creating the library of the future." Thanks to The Fletcher Jones Foundation, Pepperdine University is one step closer to attaining that goal.
