 - 2. As for the co-curricular, the areas of GE will move to a 7-year cycle as well. Whenever possible, they will be tied to the program reviews. The "Christianity and Culture" GE requirement will be up for program review in the same year as the Religion Division, for example. Where the areas of GE do not mesh with one specific division or program, those areas will follow their own 7-year reporting calendar. Data will be collected each year, so this switch does not eliminate annual reports.
