II. Program Reviews

- A. Tonya Wood presented a HuTE: SAAJ review findings summary.
 - a. It is a 4-course colloquium that doesn't have a degree or a director. It is missing lots of elements. The data for the program isn't tracked close enough to provide quality data, due to the small size of the program. It was discussed that the program has PLOs that connect to ILOs, but there isn't a good data set to track how they are followed through.
 - b. The idea of creating a group review for HuTE was discussed. Similar sentiments about data tracking were shared regarding the Great Books Colloquium review.
