II. New Business

A. Accessible texts - Sandy Harrison

Sandy Harrison provided an overview of the Office of Student Accessibility (formerly known as the Disability Services Office) and the current issues the office is facing. In order to be in compliance, students need to be given accessible texts. The issue is that professors sometimes assign articles or books that are not available in accessible format. The screenreader needs clean copies of PDF or Word documents in order to read clearly. If textbooks are not available in accessible format, one option that the Office of Student Accessibility has is to have Printing Services remove the binding for cleaner copies to be made. Another issue that the office faces is recording of lectures, as some professors are uncomfortable with being recorded. However, if these and other accommodations are not made available to the students, Pepperdine is vulnerable to claims of discrimination. UAC recommended improved communication of this need with faculty to ensure awareness that some materials are problematic for some students with

disabilities. The Office of Student Accessibility committed to partner with faculty when issues arise.

- B. Update on GSEP PhD program - June Schmieder-Ramirez
June Schmieder-Ramirez offered a brief report on the PhD in Global Leadership and Change at the Graduate School of Education and Psychology. In the fall, the PhD program had 40 students, which includes transfers from the EDOL program. The students seem to be very excited and pleased with the program. The challenges that remain include hiring additional full-time faculty in the global/local policy and research areas and having an enhanced assessment process for the WASC review next year.
