I am ADMITTED, what do I need to do next?

Step 1: I am attending Graziadio; I must complete the "[Notice of Intent to Enroll](#)" online and pay the \$1000 deposit (\$650 due with Intent and \$350 due by May 15, 2012) to confirm my attendance.

Step 2: I am a domestic student and need financial aid assistance. I can go to the [financial aid](#) website to complete the application.

Domestic students skip to **Step 4**

Step 3: I am an **International student** so I must do the following items.

Complete the I-20 process by contacting the Office of International Student Services (OISS) at OISS@pepperdine.edu.

Attend [SPLASH](#), the international student orientation, on **August 14, 2012**.

Complete the mandatory immunizations and submit the [Health History Form](#). I can receive my immunizations in my home country before I arrive or I can receive my immunizations at the Health Center on campus, but understand there will be charges.

Step 4: I am **required** by Pepperdine University to have health insurance, how do I find out more? You can go online to review the [health insurance](#) information.

Step 5: I need to submit my Resume to the Career Services Office by **August 1, 2012**. I can do this by creating an account in [GTO \(Graziadio Talent Online\)](#) and posting my Resume online.

MS students skip to **Step 7**.

Step 6: I am an MBA student and would like to sign-up for waiver exams to test out of some of the core requirements. The 12 month MBA and the MS programs are not eligible for this. Where do I sign up? You can sign-up for [Course Waivers](#) online. When is the test? The test will be available online between **June 11 and July 6, 2012**.

Step 7: I am moving to California, where will I live? I can live on-campus or off-campus. For more information, I can visit the [housing](#) website. To request [on-campus housing](#), contact the housing office using your Pepperdine email at housing@pepperdine.edu.

Step 8: I need to know more about my program requirements, the school's academic information, and about official academic policies. Where do I find this information? The [Academic Catalog](#) will answer all of these questions.

Step 9: I am excited about my fall classes. When will I receive the [Class Registration Information](#)? I will get an email the **week of June 24, 2012** and will register for classes the **week of July 10, 2012**.

Step 10: I am **required** by my admission letter to attend one of the Summer 2012 courses below:

Choose one:

- I am required to complete the [Quantitative Methods Online Course](http://cb.hbsp.harvard.edu/cb/access/11102936) (<http://cb.hbsp.harvard.edu/cb/access/11102936>) by **June 15, 2012**. And attend the 2-day summer course [DESC 551 Mathematics and Statistics Review for Pre-MBA Students](#) on **August 15 and 16, 2012**.
- I am required to attend and complete the summer course, [GSBM 550 Professional English Communication Skills for Pre-Graduate Students](#) on **July 30 – August 10, 2012** on the Malibu campus.

Step 11: I must be on campus for the [Orientation](#) Kick-off on **Thursday, August 16, 2012**. I will get more information by email the week of **July 10, 2012**.

Step 12: I will be enrolled in the [BSCI 650 Personal and Leadership Development Workshop](#) course. What is this course and when does it take place? This is your first class at Graziadio. It is a two-day retreat focusing on personal leadership. This workshop will take place between **August 17, 2012 and August 26, 2012**. You will receive an email your assigned section number and specific workshop dates the week of **July 10, 2012**.
