To access Courses by Sakai, go to courses.pepperdine.edu and log in with your Pepperdine NTID and password.





Find your course by clicking on "Sites" in the top right-hand corner.


Add your course to your favorites by clicking the star, and it will be added to your toolbar on the top of your screen.
