Transit Stops at HHC

For employees' convenience, there are two bus stops located strategically inside the Center. The stops are served by the three bus lines described below.

Commuter Express 574

The 574 travels from the San Fernando Valley to HHC. It originates in Sylmar and is nonstop between Encino and HHC.

Culver CityBus Line 6

Line 6 travels between UCLA and the Aviation Green Line station. There is also a Rapid 6 for your convenience.

Metro 439

This line travels between Union Station and the Aviation Green Line station. Metro link commuters may use the 439 free of charge.

PUBLIC TRANSIT SUBSIDIES AND BENEFITS

Public transit commuters participate in a bimonthly \$10,000 cash incentive distributed among alternative commuters.

A guaranteed complimentary ride via taxi or rental car is offered to all public transit (and other alternative) commuters in an emergency or an unexpected work-late or leave-early situation.

Public transit subsidy requirements: All participants must leave work within the hours of 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. to be eligible for cash commuting subsidies.
