Important Reminders for Expense Reimbursements

To ensure timely processing of your <u>expense reimbursements</u>, please adhere to the following best practices:

- **120-Day Deadline**: Per University <u>policy</u>, after 120 days, reimbursements become taxable income.
- **Single PDF Document**: We recommend using Adobe Acrobat Pro to combine all receipts into a single PDF document for submission (**Download instructions** for Adobe Acrobat Pro)
- Per Diem Option: Consider utilizing the per diem option for eligible expenses.
- Additional Support: For further assistance or questions regarding expense reimbursements, please contact Spencer Hardman.

NEW Incomplete Grade Submission Process

When considering assigning an "Incomplete" grade, faculty should leave the grade field on the grade roster empty. Instead, the "Notification of Incomplete Grade" <u>form</u> must be filled out by the grading deadline. This form is then sent to the Program Office, which forwards it to the Registrar's Office for entry of the "I" grade into WaveNet.

It's crucial to remember that the "I" grade must be replaced with a final grade (A-F or CR/NC) by the end of the following trimester. If a final grade isn't submitted by this deadline, the "I" will automatically become an "F". See <u>website</u> for additional information.
