

Dear Colleagues,

As we enter a new year, we tend to set new personal goals. With that same spirit of growth and opportunity, we're excited to share some of the curriculum changes we're planning for the year ahead.

First, we are working on our "One MBA," essentially aligning the classes between Part-time and Online MBA programs. This is meant to boost flexibility for students to seamlessly choose between online and on-ground classes. Second, we're focusing our recruitment efforts on our 12-month MBA program, again hoping to boost enrollment with an opportunity to re-enter the workforce faster and at a lower overall cost. Third, we will pivot our MSGB program towards Global Business Sustainability to align with market trends and to boost the enrollment of our domestic students. Lastly, we will pilot some select classes that could be shared between programs with a view to developing a common core for several of our MS programs.

## \*New Pilot Program\* "Pepperdine Syllabus" Tool

The <u>Simple Syllabus</u> pilot program is coming to Pepperdine via Canvas in the Spring 2025 term. As part of the pilot program, PGBS online faculty can easily create and customize syllabi using a school-approved template with pre-filled data from PeopleSoft, with more features to come. The dashboard lets professors track student engagement and the tool supports the school with consistent templates, including required notices, and simplifying the accreditation processes.

#### **Executive Education and Contract Units**

A new policy has been established for Pepperdine Graziadio School of Business faculty to count Executive Education (EE) courses towards their contract units for existing, or new EE programs. The EE compensation rates can be viewed on the <u>Faculty Affairs site</u>.
