## **Accreditation/Assessment Updates**

The Accreditation and Assessment team is excited to announce that the department is implementing a new assessment management system! We are currently working on transitioning from our old system, LiveText, which we have contracted until Summer 2024, to a new system, Outcomes Assessment Projects (OAP). Both systems are Watermark products. We are switching from LiveText to OAP because LiveText is being discontinued and OAP has more sophisticated reporting capabilities.

OAP will be fully implemented by the end of Spring 2024 term, with some potential testing happening throughout fall and spring. We ask for your patience as you may be selected to assess in your course with our new system. Like before, assessment just requires scoring a rubric and attaching the student's work if it is available.

Assessment results are not shared with students, and students do not have any access to OAP. If you are asked for an assessment, we will work to ensure that you have all of the proper training materials so that you can successfully complete the assessment in OAP.
