Over this next year, we are committed to continuing our process improvement by collaborating with our IT team to: streamline the creation of the year-long master schedule, improve reporting, and automate tracking/communication.

#### Per Diem Guidelines for PGBS Faculty

### **New University Panopto Retention Policy**

<u>Panopto</u> has ended its practice of free, unlimited video storage for our lecture capture system. Due to this change, new data retention policies have been implemented at the University. All recordings that have not been viewed in over thirteen (13) months have been auto-archived.

An archived video is placed in a long-term storage state. While it can be retrieved, it can take up to 48 hours to restore an archived video. See more information on restoring an archived video.

All Graziadio faculty are encouraged to review their course sites for embedded Panopto content ahead of time to ensure that enough time is allotted for archived videos to be restored to an active state.
