


If you are electing the **Aetna Broad HMO** or **Aetna Value Network HMO** plan for 2024, you will be asked to provide a **PCP Code** during the enrollment process for you and any of your dependents. This code will allow Aetna to assign you to your preferred primary care physician(s), simplifying the transition process from Pepperdine's current Anthem plans.



The **PCP Code** is a 5- or 6- digit number that is associated with a primary care physician (PCP) in Aetna's directory. Please follow the instructions below to find the appropriate code.

- 1) If you do not currently have a PCP, and have no assignment preference, please enter "000000" in the PCP Code field. This will prompt Aetna to auto-assign you a PCP within 30 miles of your home address on file.
- 2) If you have a current PCP that you wish to be assigned to in 2024, confirm they are in-network with the plan you have selected by using the appropriate links below to search Aetna's directory. Use the "Continue as a Guest" field and enter your zip code to search for your doctor by name.
  - Aetna Value Network HMO
  - Aetna Broad HMO

If you see your doctor is in-network, you will also see their "Primary Care ID," which is the PCP Code needed for your enrollment.
