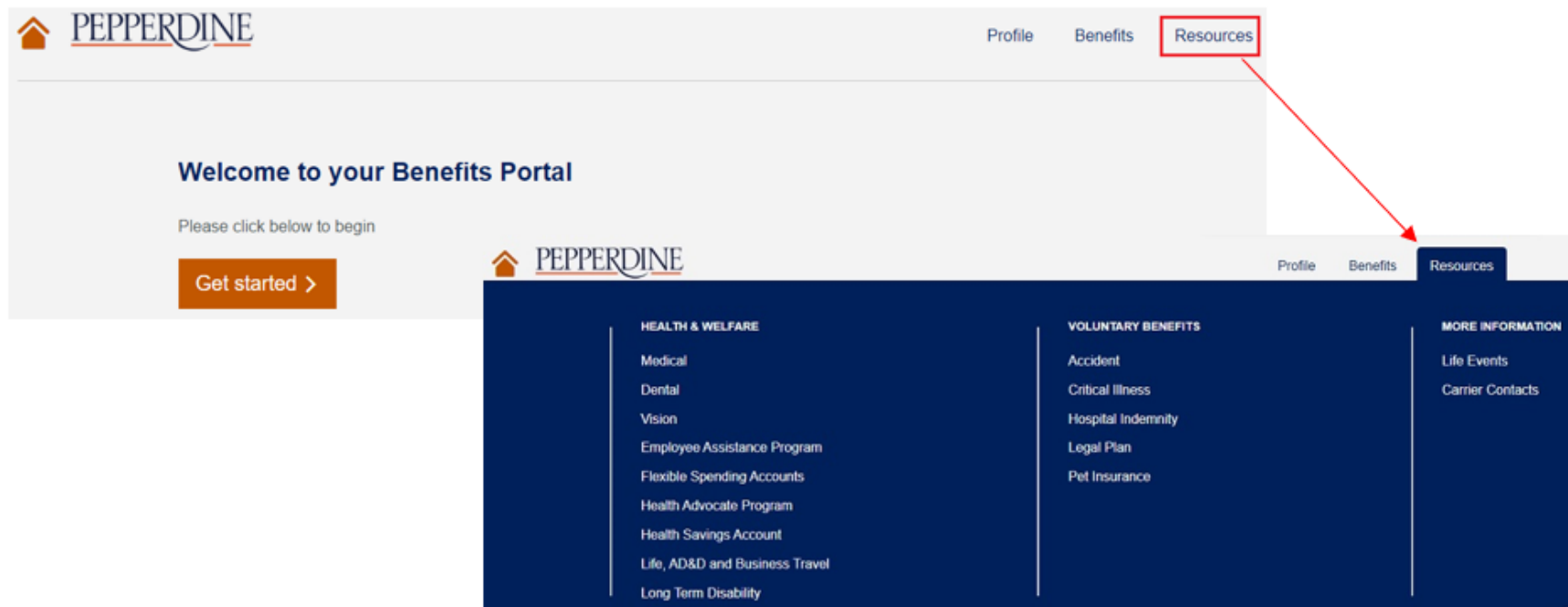


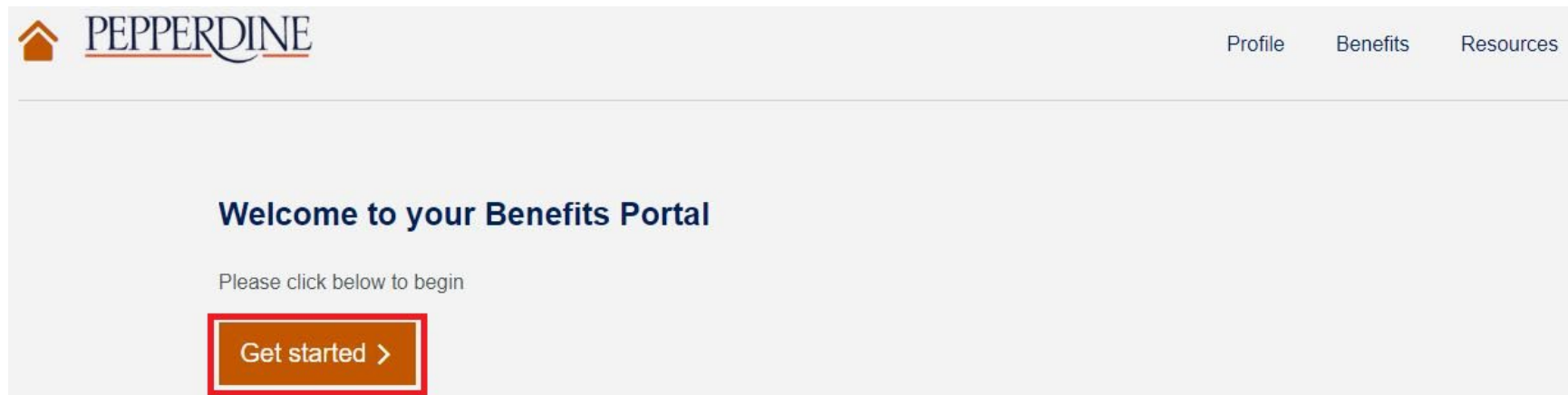
Dear Colleague,

If electing an Aetna HMO plan for 2024, this guide has been created to assist you. If you are waiving medical coverage or planning to elect the Aetna HDHP or Kaiser Permanente HMO plans, please disregard this document.

1. Visit the benefits portal at mybenefits.pepperdine.edu and input your WaveNet credentials.
2. From the benefits portal dashboard, you can review plan documents and access carrier contact information.



3. When you're ready to enroll, click the orange **GET STARTED** button. You are now asked to review your information and communication preferences, emergency contact information, and make any edits to your dependent(s).



4. Under the **MEDICAL** option, click *Begin Enrollment*, re-elect eligible dependents, and select your desired Aetna HMO plan.



5. Enter the 5- or 6-digit Aetna PCP number associated with your primary doctor in the **PCP CODE** field. You will need to complete this field for yourself and each of your enrolled dependents.
- *Need help finding your Aetna PCP Code?* A list of Aetna PCP Codes for frequently used Anthem Blue Cross primary doctors, is available to you [here](#).
- Note: PCPs listed may be in-network with only one or both Aetna HMO plans. Use the **VIEW PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER LIST** link in the upper left corner of the benefits portal screen to confirm if the doctor is in-network with the plan you elected. For general medical group network status, please review this [document](#).
- *Don't currently have a PCP?* Please input **000000** in the PCP Code field. This will allow Aetna to auto-assign you a PCP within 30 miles of your home address on file.
