Tutoring Assistance

6 weeks - 12 years

- KinderCare
 - This daycare offers a distance learning option at some of its locations.
 - Open Monday through Friday, times vary location.
 - o Price varies dependent on location, frequency of visits, age, and program.

3 years +

- Kumon
 - Extra help in math and reading.
 - o Offers their own curriculum in-person or virtually.
 - Meetings are twice a week and 30 minutes per subject.
 - Students are given homework to take home.
 - o Tutors will help students with special needs.
 - One-time materials fee of \$30 and a registration fee of \$50.
 - There is a current promotion available before October 15th, no registration fee.
 - o \$160/month.
 - Prices may vary per location, this is for the Thousand Oaks location.

4 years +

- Sylvan Learning
 - Available online or in-person.
 - Distance learning: Students are given help with the curriculum their school has given them. They can meet all day, 8am - 3pm, or half a day.
 - Skills learning: Meet 4-6 times a week for 50 minutes based on what skills they need to improve.
 - Distance Learning: Half day = \$1,200/month. Full day = \$2,000/month
 - Skills Learning: Dependent on how frequently you meet and what the needs are.

5 Years - 8th Grade

- Boys and Girls Club
 - Currently all local locations are full. A new Agoura Hills location is opening on October 1st, which will have more availability.
 - o Open Monday Friday, 8 AM 5 PM.
 - Children bring their own curriculum from their current school and staff is on sight to help.
 - o \$750/month.

5 years - College

- Lindamood-Bell Learning Center
 - Customized and virtual tutoring available all around the world.

- Offers an individualized plan and curriculum for each student based on their needs.
- o Offers tutoring help to students with special needs.
- o Initial consultation and assessment is \$395.
- One-on-one meetings start at \$124/hour.

Stowell Learning Center

- Designed for students with special needs.
- o Offers one-on-one meetings in-person or virtually.
- An individualized curriculum is created for each student based on their needs.
- o Meetings are 3-4 hours a week and scheduled on a monthly basis.
- Initial assessment and consultation is \$595.
- Monthly prices range from \$1,200 to \$1,800.
