



Spring 2019 Online Programs Course Schedule

Academic Advising: Students should work with their Student Success Advisors to plan their course schedules. Your Student Success Advisor will provide you with the approved course sequence for your program.

Residencies: Students are strongly encouraged to attend Residency 1 in the first semester of the program and to attend Residency 1 prior to Residency 2.

There is a program fee for each residency. This fee covers on-campus meals and group transportation to off-campus programming. Students shall pay for their own transportation to Malibu and accommodations. Students attending a Residency may choose to receive an additional \$2,000 (per Residency) in financial aid during the term in which they attend.

Please note, enrollment in Residencies is limited, so it is imperative that you register for these courses prior to the add/drop period for the term. If you do not enroll during the registration period, we cannot guarantee that you will be able to add the class at a later time.

Part-time Students: If you are taking a reduced load, please work with your Student Advisor to determine a schedule that meets your needs.
