RESCHEDULING EXAMS

PETITIONS TO CHANGE ONE OF TWO EXAMS SCHEDULED FOR THE SAME DAY MUST BE FILED BY THE SEVENTH WEEK OF CLASSES

As noted above, final exams will not be rescheduled unless a student has two final exams scheduled in the same day.
