

Connecting to the Pepperdine Network – Windows

Setting Up Wireless Access for Windows

1. You should see one or more icons of a pair of computers with a red “x” across them, near the clock on your screen (see example). Right-click that icon. Choose Open Network Connections from the menu.
2. Right-click the “Wireless Network Connection” icon. Choose “Properties.”
3. Click the Wireless Networks tab.
4. Click the Add button.
5. Enter pepperdine (all lower-case) as the SSID. Make sure all the other check boxes are *not* checked off. *(If asked whether there should be Data Encryption choose disable—WEP should **not** be enabled.) Then click OK.*
6. Click Advanced and click the “Access Point (infrastructure) networks only” radio button.
7. The icon on your system tray (next to the clock on your screen) should now appear without the X (it may take several seconds to update)
8. Proceed too Registering with WavesConnect

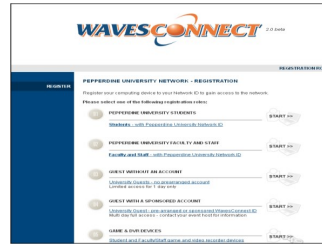


Registering with WavesConnect

From your computer, mobile phone, or tablet open a web browser (i.e. Internet Explorer, Safari, Firefox, or Chrome) and enter the following in the address bar: if it doesn't automatically come up

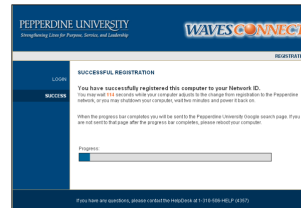

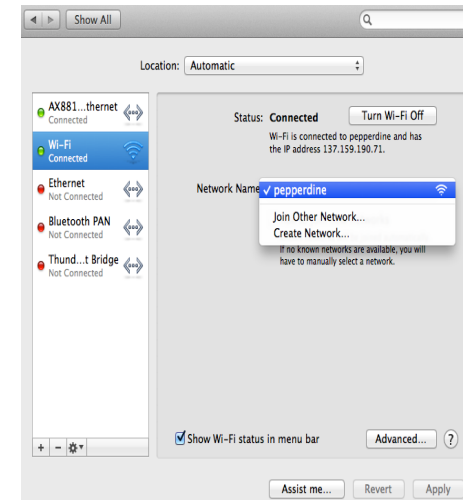
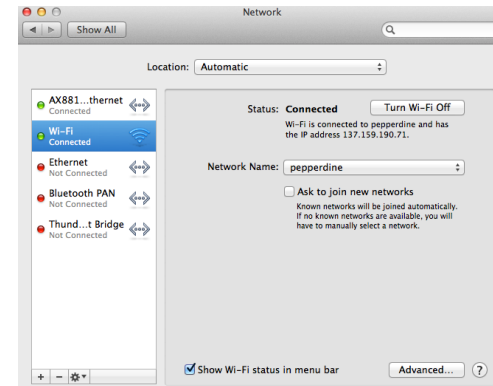

Setting Up Wireless Access for Mac

Start out with Apple then click **System Preferences**. Now,



Scroll down the Network Names until you see **Pepperdine** and click **Apply** in the Lower Right.
