### **Announcements**

- Fall Enrollment and Yield – Kristy Collins presented a report about the Fall 2018 Enrollment and Yield with a target enrollment of approximately 800 students. On April 9 they plan to send yield communications to divisional deans including a list of students for faculty to personally call as an effective outreach to admitted students.
