

How to Register for Classes

Follow instructions below in order to find courses, add courses to your cart, and register for your classes.

1. Log in to your Wavenet Account

3. The search window should pop up. Make sure that when you are searching for classes that you are selecting the correct term for the classes you are looking to register for. If it's Fall 2018, but you're registering for classes for the next semester, set your term to "Spring 2019" -- the January through April term.

4. Any of the following search methods will work, but it's often easiest to search by the course number. If you're registering for a class in an abroad location, it may be easiest to use the "Additional Search Criteria" drop down menu and search by "Location."

- 1. Make sure that you are searching for classes in the correct term that you are looking to register for.** (Points to the 'Term' dropdown menu, which is set to 'Spring 2019').
- 2. Search for classes via any of these methods. But the easiest is to type in a course number. Example: typing '111' into the box will lead you to any class that has '111' in the title. So it should pull up all offering for HUM 111.** (Points to the 'Course Number' dropdown menu, which is set to 'is exactly').
- 3. If you're registering for a class in an abroad location, it may be easiest to search for a class by location. However, it will also pop up on other search methods, just make sure you're choosing the course with the correct location!** (Points to the 'Location' dropdown menu in the 'Additional Search Criteria' section).

The 'Additional Search Criteria' section includes options for Meeting Start Time, Meeting End Time, Days of Week, Instructor Last Name, Class Nbr, Course Keyword, Minimum Units, Maximum Units, Course Component, Session, Mode of Instruction, Campus, and Location. The 'Location' dropdown is currently set to 'Location'.

***Each International Program location has a different section number. Make sure that you are registering for the course in your program by making sure that the section number matches that of your program.**

- Florence: .95
- Heidelberg: .91
- Lausanne: .93
- London: .92
- Shanghai: .96
- Washington, D.C.: .72

5. For example, let's find Humanities 111 on campus. It's important to take HUM 111 before going abroad because most programs offer HUM 212 and HUM 313, but require HUM 111 as a prerequisite. If you're attending a program in the fall, they will offer HUM 212, if you're attending in the spring, they will offer HUM 313. Make sure to check what classes are being offered in your specific program before planning what you will need to take before you leave. Every program offers different class options at different times!

1. By searching for course '111' it pulled up all classes with '111' in the title. In this case, HUM 111 and MUS 111 both appear; make sure you're looking at the correct class!

2. This shows all HUM 111 classes being offered in Spring 2019. You can see which days and times the class is held, what room it will be in, and who the professor is. By selecting class materials you can find what textbooks will be used in that class.

3. The status of the class will tell you if a class can be enrolled in or if it's full. If it's full, you can email the department office manager and request to be put on a waitlist for the class.

6. Click 'Select' for the class that you want to be enrolled in. You are not committed to this class by clicking 'Select,' even after you register, you can go back and add and drop more classes provided that they aren't closed. You will then be taken to a page that show the information for the class you selected. Double check that you have selected the correct course and then hit 'Next.'

Wavenet will ask you to confirm that you understand that you are registering for those classes and remind you that you are able to add and drop those classes until the end of the add/drop period, which typically falls at the end of the first week of the term. Accept that agreement and confirm your classes. Your classes will then show up in that term's class schedule.

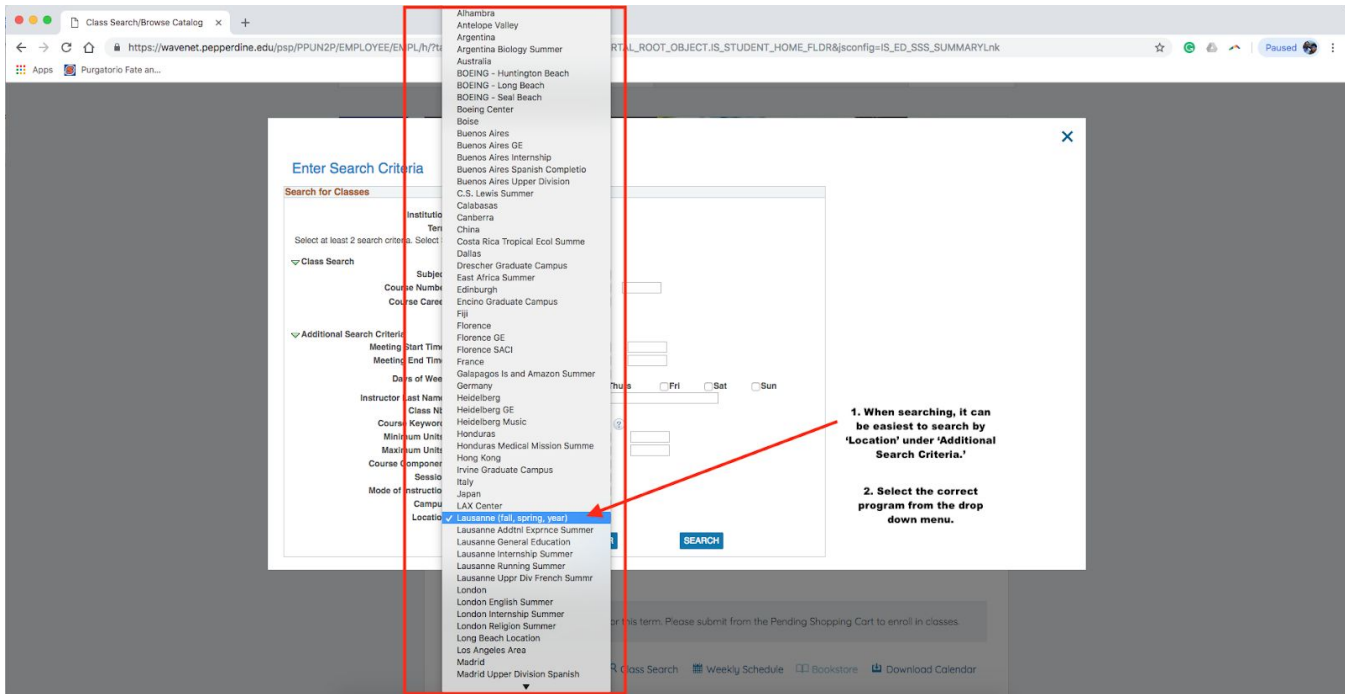
NOTES:

If there is a class that you need to take that you weren't able to register for because it was closed, please contact the office manager of the division that the class belongs to -- i.e. Religion 101 is a part of the Religion Department. In some cases, you can opt to take some classes in subsequent semesters, but please make sure that you are getting the classes that are prerequisites for the classes you will need while you are abroad. Plan ahead!

If you need to change the classes, you can add any open class or drop any class with no penalty until the end of the add/drop period at the end of the first week of the term that those classes are in. For example, if you have registered for Religion 102 and then you realize that you want to take it abroad and not before, you can drop Religion 102 until the end of the first week that you are taking the class.

Registering for IP Courses

If you are register for a class in an abroad location, follow steps 1-4. When searching for a class, choose the location for the class you are searching for.



The search should pull up results for all of the classes at a particular program. You can register for classes through here the same way you would for a Malibu campus class.
