Be sure your passport is valid for at least 6 months PAST the return date for your program.



The visa process can take 8-10 weeks, so start EARLY, especially if you are a non-U.S. passport holder.



3 REGISTER FOR CLASSES

> Be sure you can take the minimum number of units required for your program, and register for any pre-reqs.



ATTEND ORIENTATION 4

> Talk to program alum, meet your group and enjoy free breakfast and lunch.

TALK TO YOUR DOCTOR & INSURANCE COMPANY 5

> Complete your Health Clearance Form with your doctor and submit it to IP. Make sure you are covered for your health needs abroad.

PREPARE FOR YOUR FLIGHT 6

> Share your itinerary with your family so they're in the know. If you're flying separately from the group, submit your itinerary to IP.
