

Chinese Visa Offices

Students traveling to Shanghai will need to obtain Chinese visas. Once you have received the required documents from the IP office (JW202 Form, Fudan Invitation Letter, Pepperdine IP Entry Letter), you must gather all required materials and submit them IN PERSON at a Chinese Consulate or through a *visa expeditor. All visa offices are listed below. You must go to the office that serves the state you listed as your home address on the visa application.

Please note that if you use A Briggs, their website will provide you with a list of required documents, which may vary from the list below. Please follow their list of requirements if you are planning on using their services.
