Details about each fee

Tuition: Same as in Malibu for all IP Programs

Room & Board: \$7,455 is equivalent to a freshmen residence hall double with a declining balance Extra Meal Plan. For information on meal plans provided in each program, see program manuals on our website.

Student Government Association Fee: standard for all Seaver students

Textbooks: Exact textbooks are specific to student's course selections. IP will send an email prior to depature with what books you'll need and how to purchase them.

Loan Fees: Applies to students with loans.

Transportation and Personal Expenses: Malibu estimated costs.

International Programs Fee (IP Fee) includes rountrip airfare, the Educational Field Trip, orientations, and local excursions. Roundtrip airfare costs for students studying both in fall & spring semesters in the same location is \$1,220 and is included in the Fall IP Fee. As a result, the Spring IP Fee is \$1,220 less. The flight cost for the Washington DC program is \$500. If you live outside of California, you can indicate your intent to fly separately from the group when you sign your contract and the round trip airfare will be deducted from the IP Fee.

Local Country Fees: Specific to each program, please see our website for specific information.

PE & Course Fees: Applies to certain courses- see the Seaver Academic Catalog for specific information.

Personal Abroad Expenses Estimate: Personal spending varies by student and program location. Per semester, IP suggests \$250 in DC and Shanghai, \$350 in Buenos Aires, \$750 and Europe.

Passport Fee: Varies depending on where you request your passport and how quickly you request to have it.

Visa Fee: Specific to each program, please see our website for specific information
